## **VI. Sharing Session:**

- A. Mike VP brought up the Regional Inventory and stated that the Regional PI focus on only the State Fair booth that was discussed during the sub-committee meeting will be forwarded to the Region as part of the Inventory.
- B. The discussion of Ragbrai continued from the subcommittee meeting to the Sharing Session, it was decided that the SWINA PI Committee will be charged with gathering the information for Ragbrai next year, and if in the SWINA Area they will be in charge of contacting the point person of Ragbrai to get more information on how to let the bike riders know that we are here and where our meetings are being held whether they be regular scheduled meetings or special meetings held for this event only. More will be revealed.
- C. Charlotte S. brought up the fact that the SWINA ASC is completely out of meeting lists, and that it is listed as the PI Chairpersons duty to keep the ASC supplied with meeting lists. However, since ENNA requires us to show up at either their ASC, it makes it difficult to get them. Mary R. will get a copy of the meeting list and get them printed and have some available at the Luau.

Kevin G. brought up that having meeting list available at the Luau does not help the groups that are currently out of meeting lists. Jeff S. passed out the PI meeting list for groups that do not have any, and this will hold them over until we are able to resolve the problem.

- D. Mike VP discussed the Regional CAR Just For today Motion and explained that it will be to change the 13 passages of the Just For Today that are no longer in our Basic Text. See addendum for complete motion. This will be included on the agenda for the July ASC.

Charlotte S. motioned for a break, seconded by Don N. M/S/C/U.

Laura W. called the meeting back to order @ 3:50 p.m. with a moment of silence followed by the Serenity Prayer.

## **VIII: Unfinished Service:**

- A. Phone Line Liaison Nominations: Bill S. was nominated by Colene L. and seconded by Mary R. Kevin G. called for a vote. Bill was asked to “turn his back” so that he could not see the actual vote. Congrats Bill S.
- B. PI Flier Update: Jeff S. reported that it officially kicked off on June 20<sup>th</sup> and we have already received 4 calls on the Phone Line requesting information. He also reported that more fliers are available if any group needs more. And, please make sure that the list of places that fliers were placed needs to be returned to the PI Committee by the July ASC.

- C. GSR Handbooks: Charlotte reported that after today most groups that have been attending the ASC has received their GSR Handbooks. The ASC decided that the Stockpile should keep 2 GSR Handbooks in Stock at all times, currently there is only one Handbook in the Stockpile. Charlotte will make sure that one more is made up and will get it to Matt to store in the stockpile.

## **IX: Current Service:**

- A. IRCNA Hospitality Room-Mary R. reported that SWINA and Visions of Hope will be sharing a 3 hour time slot. Visions of Hope has donated \$25.00 toward the purchase of items needed to make sloppy joes. The ASC has also donated \$25.00 for a total of \$50.00 for this event.
- B. During the Activities Committee meeting the committee decided that the only place for SWINA this year is Pioneer Park. There was some discussion regarding the shower situation at the Park, and there only being 2 showers total at that location. Brian V. is checking with the Shenandoah Pool as well as the Armory to see if we could use their showers as we have done in the past. The price of camping is \$5.00 for tent camping and \$10.00 for campers, this is per family per night. Mary R. will be the one collecting the camping fees, and the committee will pay the park in lump sum, as they have requested.
- C. SWINA Logo: "A Burning Desire" got the most votes but because of the amount of colors on the logo, it will be very expensive to produce. Back to Basics received the second highest votes and since it will be one color print, it will be very cost effective to produce. After discussion the logo and theme was opened to all of the ASC members and Back to Basics was a unanimous vote.
- D. Audit of SWINA ASC Account and SWINA Literature Account: It was suggested that Joe W. from Omaha and Michelle H. from SWINA be asked to do the audit of these accounts. A Vote of Confidence was given for both. More will be reported on this at the July ASC.
- E. SWINA Speakers: Mary brought up that there has been contact made to three individuals and requested willingness to speak at the campout. Sherry from Heartland Area was chosen as the main speaker if she is willing. Adam from Clean & Free was chosen as our spirituality speaker if he is willing.
- F. Regional CAR Motion: Mike VP read the motion to the ASC that the Region has submitted to the Conference Agenda Report. Charlotte S. reported that due to the deadline for submitting CAR motions, the Region approved the motion with the intent that we could submit the motion, but if the groups in the Iowa Region do not approve of the motion then the RD could withdraw the motion at a later date. See addendum for complete motion.

G. Visions of Hope motioned that ENNA either remove the ASC information from the meeting list, or have SWINA's information included on the next printing. Made by Mary R. and seconded by Tim H. It was reported that a request to have SWINA ASC information be included on the meeting list has been made and was not done at the last printing.

During the discussion it was brought up that we have had several incidences with the ENNA Area, and it is apparent that "we don't play well in the sandbox together" and that maybe it is time to print our own meeting list, and stop this constant issue with that area.

Laura W. reported that is now 4:30 p.m. and that without a motion to extend we will have to finish discussing this issue at the next ASC.

Motion to extend for 10 minutes, made by Don N. and seconded by Mark O. 9/1/0. ASC extended till 4:40 p.m.

Mary R. withdraws the previous motion, and the Tim H. who seconded the motion approves of the withdraw. Charlotte S. makes a motion for the SWINA ASC to print their own meeting list/seconded by at least 7 GSR's. Kevin G. calls the question. 8/0/2.\ Motion carries.
